On Saturday 19 March 2016, Queenslanders will vote for their local government mayor and councillors. On the same day, Queenslanders will also be required to vote on a state referendum question regarding four-year fixed terms for the Legislative Assembly of Queensland.

Queenslanders cannot cast a vote in person while overseas for the 2016 local government elections. They will be required to lodge a postal vote application with the ECQ to receive ballot papers and return them directly to the ECQ.
